

He was brutally beaten up by the Sakhinetipalli sub-inspector, the Malkipuram assistant sub-inspector and some other cops, the HRF said.

HRF state secretary Y. Rajesh and its district president Mutyala Srinivasa Rao made the demand after they went to the spot and collected details of the incident.

They said Venkateswara Rao was talking to his friend by parking his vehicle on the left side of the road without creating any hurdle to the traffic -- near Mendupalem bridge in Kesavadastupalem village of Sakhinetipalli mandal, at night, on July 30.

TEACHER BOOKED FOR MISBEHAVING WITH STUDENTS

A government high school teacher was booked on charges of misbehaving with girl students at Pedaogirala village of Vuyyuru mandal in Krishna district. According to Pedaogirala police, the school teacher identified as Saibaba who used to teach maths at the government high school in the village was misbehaving with the girl students of class IX and X for some time.

When the students complained about it to their parents, they arrived at the school on Monday and staged a protest demanding the school head master to initiate action against the said teacher. Later, they lodged a complaint with the police who in turn booked a case under relevant sections of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 against the teacher. Krishna DEO Tahera Sultana said, "We have placed the school teacher under suspension and ordered an inquiry into the incident. We will not tolerate such misbehaviour in the school."

Nellore airport to come up at alternative site

New location will be between Ongole and Kavali

In a bid to benefit the air passengers of both Prakasam and SPSR Nellore district, alternative site is being proposed for the greenfield Airport for Nellore between Ongole and Nellore Cities.

It may be recalled that the revenue authorities had already handed over 1,100 acres near Dagadathi village to the Andhra Pradesh Airport Development Corporation Ltd (APADCL), a SPV (Special Purpose Vehicle) last year.

Revenue officials were also in the process of acquiring 488.42 acres belonging to the Forest

Department and identified alternative land for compensatory afforestation. In this backdrop, a decision was taken to shift the Airport location during the recent visit of the Chief Minister for the groundbreaking ceremony of Ramayapatnam Port.

According to official sources, the new location will be between Ongole and Kavali, and it will be close to Ramayapatnam Port and the midpoint to

both Ongole and Nellore Cities. Referring to the state government's plans to develop airport-linked industries and cargo handling facilities at the proposed airport, a senior official reminded that they are also acquiring land for Mega Industrial Hub close to Ramayapatnam Port.

He said they have identified 3 alternative sites measuring 1500 to 2000 acres between Singarayakonda and Kavali for the airport and sent the proposals to the government. The official added that the land acquisition will not be an issue because the entire land belongs to the state government.

The Minister for IT and industries Gudivada Amarnath visited the factory premises. "As far as I know 50 women fell sick after inhaling the gas," Amarnath told this correspondent.

Anakapalle superintendent of police Gowthami Sali said the gas leaked at about 6.45 pm. There were about 2,000 women in the second shift who were to be relieved at 10 pm.

"We are inquiring into the incident. All the workers who were admitted in various hospitals are reported to be safe and out of danger," the district police chief said.

Spokesperson of the Brandix Apparel India City said all the employees present there have been evacuated.

Environmentalists and trade union leaders

blamed the government for not taking action against the management after the June 3 incident. The activists said the unit was closed soon after the June 3 incident but shortly thereafter, it resumed operations, whereas the closeby unit of the Porus company was still shut down

The state government constituted an experts committee to probe the incident but the contents of the report were yet to be made public, the activists claimed.

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2 girls go missing in Kankipadu

A girl studying ninth standard allegedly eloped with a married man living next door at Kankipadu of Krishna district on Monday.

According to the Kankipadu police, two girls in their ninth standard at ZP High School at Kankipadu went missing. The two girls left the school on Monday afternoon and reached home and informed their parents that they were asked to bring their Aadhaar cards and collected them and went away from home.

When they failed to return home after school, their parents approached the school authorities and asked about their daughters. However, the school authorities informed them that the girls left the school

in the afternoon stating that they were asked to come home. Suspecting foul play, their parents lodged a complaint with the police.

The police, during inquiry, noticed the missing of a married man living next door to one of the two girls. The married man's wife was out of station as she went to her parents' house to deliver a baby.

The police checked the CCTV footage at the Vijayawada railway station and found the two girls, along with the married man identified as Joji, and all the three boarded a train proceeding towards Chennai.

The police suspect that one of the two girls might have developed a close relationship with the married man and she eloped with him by taking the help of her friend to be with her.
